What is Respite Care?

Respite care is short-term inpatient care provided to the individual only when necessary to relieve the family members or other persons caring for the individual at home. Respite care may only be provided in a Medicare participating hospital or hospice inpatient facility or a Medicare or Medicaid participating nursing facility. Respite care may be provided only on an occasional basis and may not be reimbursed for more than 5 consecutive days at a time. (*Medicare Benefit Policy Manual, Chapter 9, Section 40.2.2*)

REQUIREMENTS

- Short term (5-days or less)
- Medicare participating Hospital or Nursing Facility

BENEFITS
